



1. ENGLISH

I. My Autobiography

- ❖ My favourite – place, food, food, fruit, vegetable, colour, dress, flower, animal, role model, sports and games, cartoon, toy, best memory, story and festival (Select any five topics and present it on each page)

- ❖ Profession you want to become (what and why)
- ❖ Review / Conclusion : (What did you learn while making the book and how you felt after completion of book)
(Description on every page can be of five to six lines.)

II. Writing:

- Write five lines daily from any story book in cursive handwriting. (Use four ruled book)

III. Reading :

- Read daily one page from Panchatantra tales (from various publishers) and Aesop's Fables as Plays (Dreamland Publications)

2. EVS

A : Roll numbers 1-10.

My Local Ecosystem:

Enable the students collect and classify locally available leaves, rocks and the other natural items. Then let them draw / paint pictures of the ecosystem; or create a labelled diagram or model of the ecosystem. Write short descriptions of the plants and animals that they have observed on an A4 sheet paper. They will get their drawing /model and write up and speak about the same on the reopening day.



Learning Outcome: The students will be able to:

- understand the concept of an ecosystem and its components. (plants, animals, water, soil).
- identify and describe the different types of plants and animals found in a local ecosystem.
- work collaboratively to create a model of a local ecosystem.
- create artwork inspired by the natural beauty of a local ecosystem.

B. Roll numbers 11-20.

My Local Market:

Go for a walk during the vacation into a local market. Observe the goods / food items/ etc., sold there. Write a short description about the different types of food and goods sold there on an A4 sheet paper. Draw pictures of your favourite items found there and speak about the same on the reopening day.



Learning Outcome: The students will be able to:

- understand the concept of a local a market and its importance in the community.
- identify and describe the different types of goods and services available at the local market.
- learn about the value of money and how to make purchases.
- develop an appreciation for the local market as a community hub.

C. Roll numbers 21-30.

My Mini Garden:

The students will select a good and suitable spot for their mini garden. They will put some seeds of herbs or small plants in the soil. Keep watering them regularly. Look out for any bugs or other creatures that might harm plants. Create a picture of your garden. Write about your garden's progress on an A4 sheet. Capture pictures of your growing garden along with you and stick on the A4 sheet .



Learning Outcome: The students will be able to:

- recognize the role of soil, water, sunlight and air in plant growth.
- appreciate the benefits of gardening, such as reducing stress and promoting sustainability.
- learn about fractions and proportions while planting and arranging plants.
- develop responsibility and ownership by caring for the garden.

D. Roll numbers 31-40.

My Food Journey:

The students will do research on where their food comes from (local markets, farms, etc.,). Draw / paste pictures of different foods and places from where they come. Make a list of different fruits, vegetables and grains they eat. Interview the family members about their food preferences and cooking habits. Write down all these on an A4 sheet and read aloud to the peer group on the reopening day.



Learning Outcome: The students will be able to:

- Understand where food comes from.
- Learn about various nutrients and explain in detail about the different food groups.
- Develop respect for diverse culinary traditions and their significance.
- Explore the science behind cooking, nutrition, and food production.



3. MATHEMATICS

DIVISION WHEEL – WORKING MODEL

Multiplication and division teach fundamental mathematical concepts like repeated addition, equal grouping and finding missing factors. They are essential for understanding the relationship between numbers, developing problem-solving skills and building a foundation for more complex mathematical ideas.
