English

1) Design an animal

- **Objective:** Boost creativity and practice descriptive writing.
- **Instructions:**
 1. Imagine that you create a new animal.
 2. Draw and colour what it looks like and give it a name.
 3. Write a short description of your animal, including how it looks, eg. 'The firebird lives in the caves. It eats sunflowers and dances to tunes.'. This assignment is to be done on an A4 sheet.

Learning Outcomes:

- Encourage creativity and imagination by inventing a new animal.
- Enhance descriptive writing skills through detailed descriptions of the animal's physical traits, habitat, diet, and behaviour.
- Develop drawing and colouring skills in visualizing the animal.
- Foster storytelling abilities by coming up with a backstory for the fictional animal.

2) Name Hunt (Nouns)

Objective: Learn to identify Nouns and show their usage in everyday life.

Instructions:

1. Go outside or look around your home.
2. Make a list of names of people, places or pets you see or talk about (eg. *Maya, Delhi, Tommy* the dog).
3. Write 3 short sentences using the names from your list.

Learning Outcomes:

- Identify Nouns
- Practice writing complete sentences
- Build awareness of names and places around them.

EVS

1) Plants Around Us

- **Objective:** Understanding the types of plants and their uses.
- **Instructions:**
 1. Take a walk around your house or neighbourhood and identify any 5 types of plants.
 2. Draw or take pictures of each plant.
 3. Write what the plant is used for (eg. flowers for decoration, fruits for eating etc.)
 4. This assignment is to be done on an A4 sheet.

Learning Outcomes:

- Develop an understanding of the different types of plants found in the local environment.
- Recognize the various uses of plants in daily life (eg. medicinal, ornamental, edible).
- Build observation skills by identifying and documenting plants in the surroundings.
- Strengthen writing skills by writing short notes on plants and their uses.

MATHS

1)Collect and count -

Objective: Practice counting and grouping using natural objects.

Instructions:

- Ask children to collect a specific number of items (e.g., grains, twigs, flowers, 15 leaves).
- Group them by size, colour or type and paste them on an A4 sheet.
- Encourage counting aloud or writing numbers on an A4 sheet.

2) Emboss Currency coins (any 4) using pencil on A4 sheet.

Learning Outcomes:

- Number sequencing and counting.
- Understanding grouping and categorization.
- Builds one-to-one correspondence.
- Learn recognition of coins.

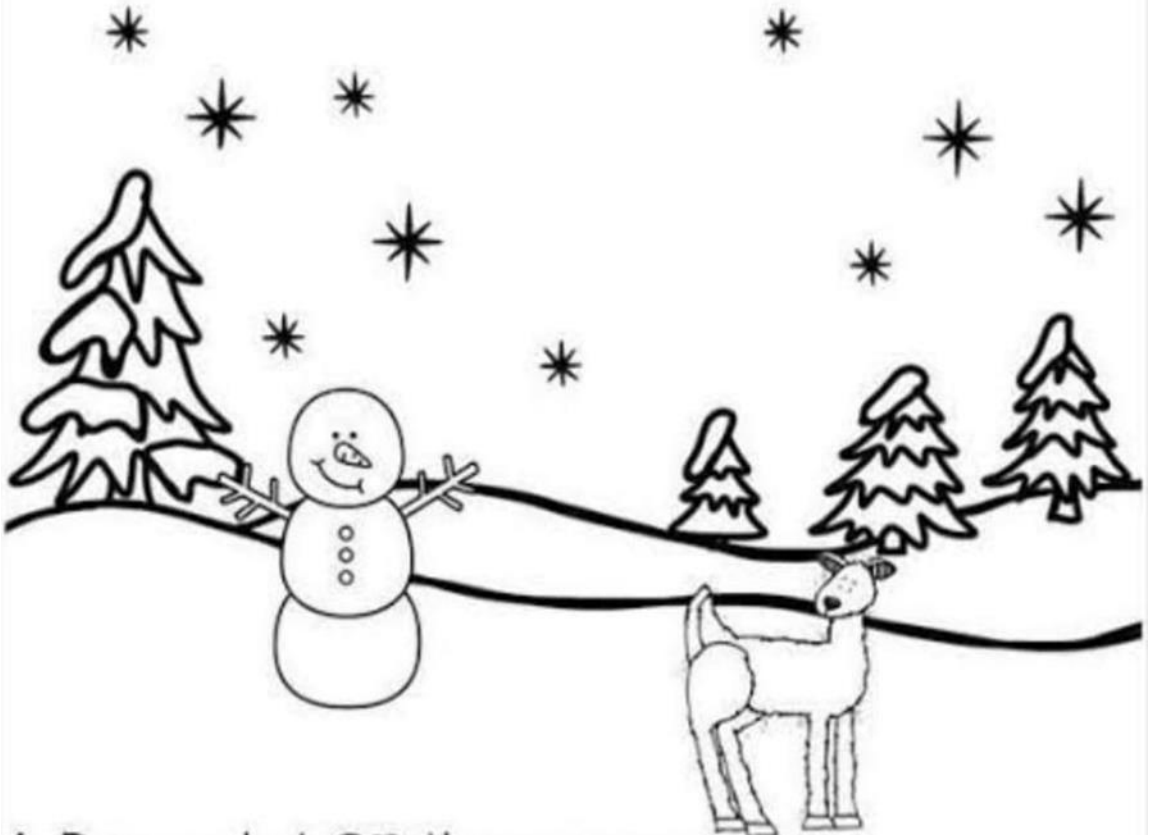
