


# AMS P.OBUL REDDY PUBLIC SCHOOL LKG SUMMER ASSIGNMEMT 2025-26

# **Activity 1:** Homemade picture Dictionary –"ALL ABOUT ME"


### **Learning outcomes:**

- ❖ My school






## **Learning outcomes:**

# **Activity:3 Paper Crumpling-My crumplefly**


# **Learning outcomes:**

#### **Learning outcomes:**


Responsibility and care, Fine motor skills, observation skills, understanding nature
