The Senior Secondary offers courses in Science, Commerce and Humanities with a variety of Optional subjects to choose from.

To enhance their intra and inter personal and leadership skills, we provide ample opportunities by organizing competitions, Youth summit -YUGEN, University Symposiums And University Fairs and lots more.

The school plays a vital role in shaping the character, loyalty, integrity and developing the personality of the student. Thus, the school imbibes these noble qualities at every step of their formative years.

## **ACCOLADES:**

- On the reopening day of the school, the management unveiled a **surprise felicitation** to 23 dedicated employees for serving the institution for more than 20 years. The list included 12 teachers, 4 administrative staff and 7 sub-staff.

Our students, Naman Pattanaik and Soham Bilolikar, won the first place in the South Zone level held at IIT Chennai and participated in the National level contest. The Project titled 'Intravenous Fluid Indicator' was designed after identifying the problem faced by the para-medic staff in keeping up with the pace to replenish the Fluid bottles. They received the 'Most Popular Choice Award', a special award by the Jury and audience together.

# 3. MAJOR EVENTS:
