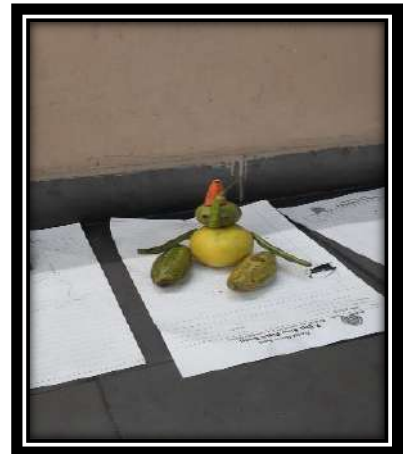


INTER HOUSE GANESH IDOL MAKING COMPETITION (ECO-FRIENDLY)

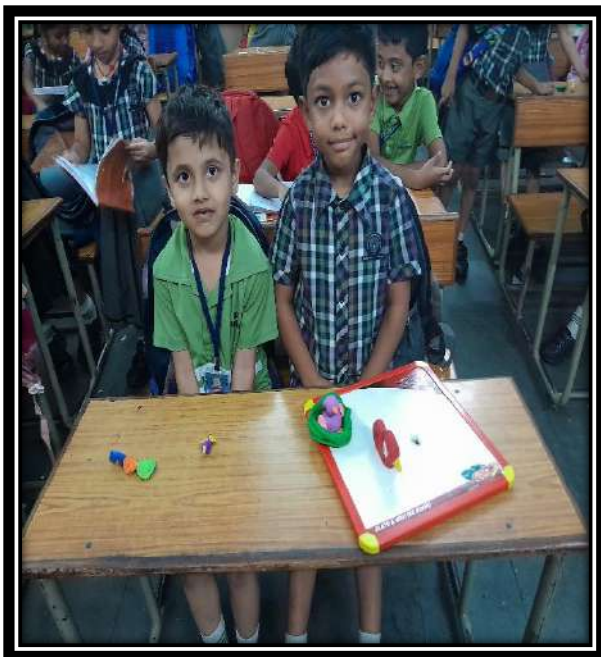
“Children are a treasure of hidden talents and new ideas.”
