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## **Second Language Recitation competition**

Recitation has its own rhythm, music, sounds & beats which are very much helpful for child's language development, cognitive development & emotional development. It helps the students to practice pitch, voice inflection & volume. Through this, a child can understand the words with different meaning but similar sounds.

Children reciting rhythmic poetry learn and understand pitch, voice inflection, and volume.

Children also learn to pick up patterns and sequences in poetry recitations. As they practice memorizing the poetry to recite, it links memory with audio and visual events, helping them develop memorization skills.

Students who recite poetry are aware of breath coordination, movements of the mouth and other physical gestures as they align these to the rhythm in the poetry. They also make use of gestures and facial expressions to connect with their audience on an emotional level.
