

Report on No Bag Day Activities

Introduction

No Bag Day was conducted for Grade 5 students with the objective of promoting experiential learning, creativity, and joyful participation without the use of regular school bags. The day focused on subject-integrated activities that enhanced students' cognitive, social, and creative skills.

Activities Conducted

1. English

Students were asked to imagine that a fairy granted them three wishes. They wrote about their wishes, illustrated them, and shared their ideas with classmates.

Materials Used: A4 white paper, stationery

Learning Outcomes:

- Enhanced creative thinking and imagination
- Improved communication and language skills



2. Mathematics

An activity titled *Exploring Circles* was conducted where students formed a human chain to represent a circle. Concepts such as centre, radius, diameter, arc, chord, and circumference were explained practically.

Materials Used: Measuring tape

Learning Outcomes:

- Better understanding of circle concepts
- Development of measurement and problem-solving skills
- Encouraged collaboration and teamwork
- Enriched mathematical vocabulary



3. EVS

Students created posters to raise awareness about environmental pollution. Topics were assigned based on roll numbers covering air, water, land, and noise pollution. Each poster included a catchy slogan.

Materials Used: A4 sheets, colour pencils, sketch pens

Learning Outcomes:

- Understanding different types of pollution
- Awareness of effects of pollution on human health
- Learning preventive measures to protect the environment



4. Language 2 (Telugu)

Students wrote a paragraph on the festival of Sankranti, pasted related kite pictures, and drew rangoli (muggulu).

Materials Used: Colour papers, colour pencils, A4 sheets

Learning Outcomes:

- Understanding the importance of Sankranti festival
- Improvement in language proficiency and cultural awareness



5. Language 3 (Hindi)

Quiz on identifying and writing words with matras, names of fruits, flowers, animals, birds, and national symbols.

Learning Outcomes:

- Improvement in language knowledge
- Enhanced memory and thinking skills
- Increased confidence and expression
