

FIELD TRIP REPORT- CLASS 6TH

On 8th January, the Class 6 students went on an educational field trip to **Udyan Utsav – the Agriculture and Horticulture Festival at Rashtrapati Nilayam**. The students departed from school at 9:00 a.m. to explore the festival.
