#### BLOCK COMMENTARY

#### FROM THE DESK OF UKG TEACHERS

We are going to tell you about the Early Programme lesson on Ticking Time.

In this lesson, students will understand that clocks and calendars help us to plan and organize ourselves

Students will sing a rhyme to learn that clocks tell time. They will do activities according to the time of the day. Students will read and show time by an hour. They will plan a picnic and realize how important it is to plan visits by time.

During language time, students will read a story on CVC words with the vowel “I”. They will read the words by blending and segmenting them and by sight. Students will match pictures to word cards and then put together words to make sentences.

During Math’s time, students use a minute sand glass to experience what a minute is, and then guess how much they can count or collect in a minute.

Rather than just reading time, students will experience how time passes and what is the duration.

At home, use a stop –watch to do 1- minute activities with your child. Gradually you could do 5-, 10 and 30- minute activities to help children notice the duration.

It would be great if your child can read the clock by an hour and plan activities such as homework **time**, play time or bed time.
