NEP AT A GLANCE

It was a great session on education, students, skilling, reskilling, and learning new tools of assessing students. It covered various aspects of Universalizing Early Childhood Care and Education. Transforming Assessment to focus on core skills setting up Performance Assessment Review and Analysis of Knowledge (PARAKH) for Holistic development. No hard compartmentalization of subjects and skills ensuring the use of Technology and equitable access to curriculum and pedagogy restructuring 10+2 to 5+3+3+4.

Focus on 21st-century skills in teaching-learning and assessment. It also covered Redesigned Board Exams, reduce “High stake” of board exams redesigned progress Card. Assessment will shift from summative to formative, and involves Observing, analyzing and then making use of Correct cognitive tools for solving a given problem.

CBSE is also planning an assessment called Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning Levels (SAFAL). It also focuses on National Professional Standards for Teachers (NPST) by the National Council for Teacher Education.
