Most Hyderabad schools record 100% pass rate in CBSE Class 10 exam results

Several Hyderabad schools reported a strong performance in the CBSE Class 10 Examinations 2026 with multiple institutions achieving a 100% pass rate.

Glendale Academy registered a 100% pass percentage with a school average of 84%. Over 99% of its students got 1st div.

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Lal at 97.4% and Ronak Gain at 96.8%. The school achieved 44 subject centums, particularly in Artificial Intelligence, Mathematics, and Social Science.

The Global Edge Group of Schools also reported five students jointly securing the top score of 97.6%. At DDMS (AMS) P. Obul Reddy Public School, Bhavya Rathi topped with 97.4% and scored 99 in Science. Similarly, Lotus Lap Public School achieved a 100% pass rate.

Oxford Grammar High School Himayathnagar also recorded a 100% pass percentage.

Narayana records 99.6%

Narayana Schools reported a pass percentage of 99.6% in CBSE Class 10 Exams. Many students also secured near-perfect scores.

Ridhi Sharma from Punjab emerged as one of the top performers, scoring 499 out of 500. Sana Sameer Gaud from Maharashtra, Naitik Dangi, Mohip Bose, Baijyanthi Banerjee from W.B., B. Sanjana Reddy and Ahaan Sajeevan from Karnataka, got 498 out of 500.

210 students got 490 marks and above. Among them, 47 students scored 495 and above, 30 crossed 496, 19 scored 497 and above, and seven got 498.

This includes Kode Sri Akshaya from Kennedy High The Global School (98.5%); Jyothika Polu from Sister Niveditha School, Ameerpet (98.4%); Reddy Bhanu Charan from Gitanjali Devakul (98%) and Savaram Lakshmi Skandaa from Jubilee Hills Public School (96.8%).

Smitha Govind, principal of Army Public School in Bollaram, said: "Our top student is Anshika Goyal, who scored 98.2%. At our school, excellence extends beyond academic achievement. This exceptional result reflects the spirit of perseverance, integrity, and holistic development that we strive to instill in every child."
