2. In partial modification of the orders issued in reference 10th cited and circumstances reported by the DSE., T.G. Hyderabad vide reference 11^h read above, Government, after careful examination of the matter, hereby extend the time period for implementation of Telugu as compulsory subject for students of studying classes IX during the academic year 2025-26 and students of Class X during the academic year 2026-27 of all the managements of Schools in Telangana State as per section 6 of the Telangana (Compulsory Teaching and Learning Telugu in Schools) Act, 2018 (Act No.10 of 2018).

3. The DSE, T.G. Hyderabad shall take further necessary action in the matter, accordingly and also take all necessary steps, immediately, to implement the rules issued vide reference 5th read above from the academic year 2026-27 onwards scrupulously.
