Principal Mrs Latha Shankar, Vice Principals Mrs Vinitha Anil and Mrs B Nagaveena also planted saplings on the occasion.

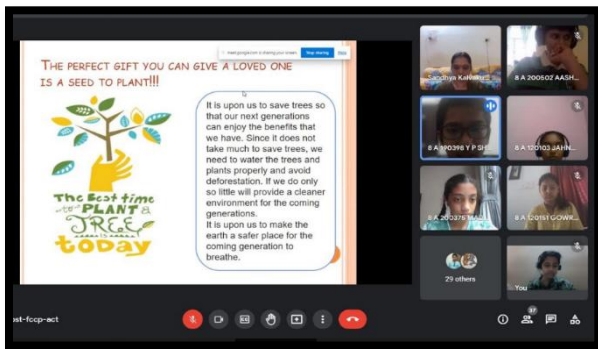

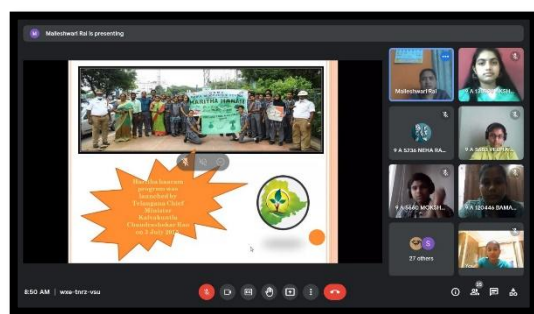
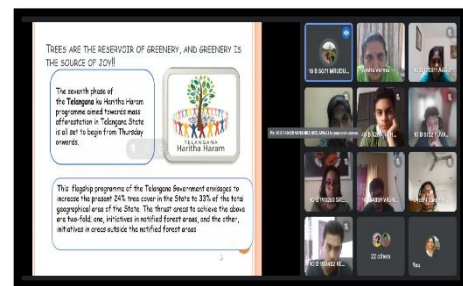
of the plants at their homes. The students of Grades 4 & 5 also presented PPTs. Some of them planted some plants in their home gardens.
