### Celebrations by Students:

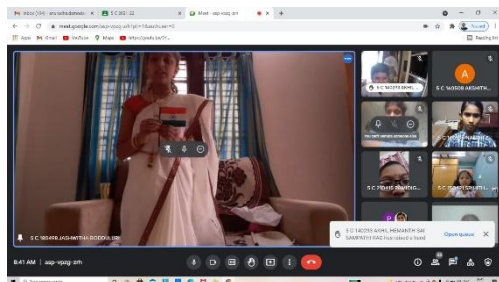

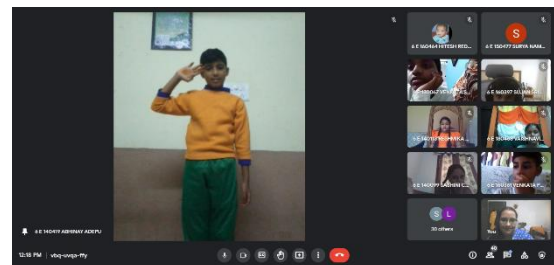
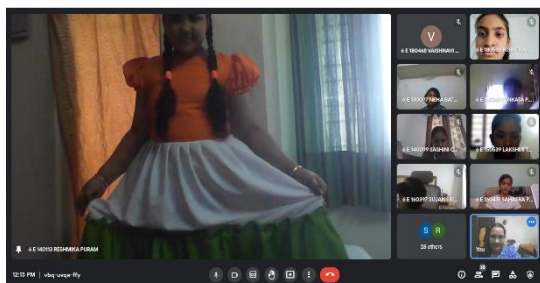
The students of Classes 1, 2, and 3 dressed themselves as the heroes of our freedom struggle, and presented their speeches in the assembly.
