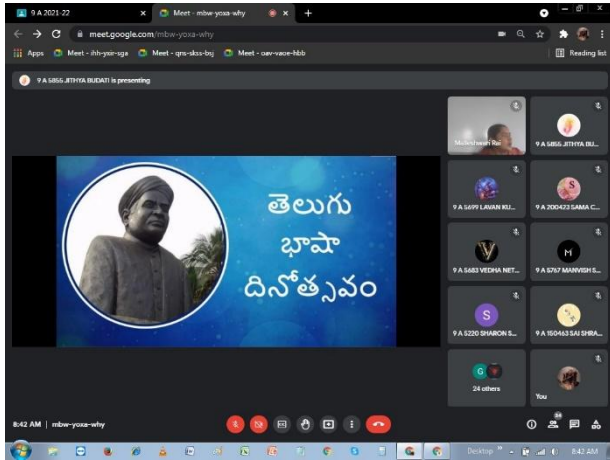
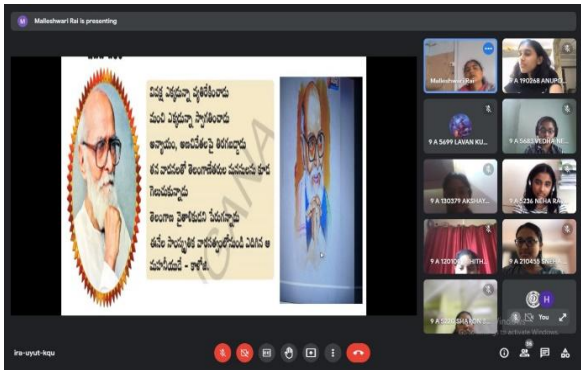
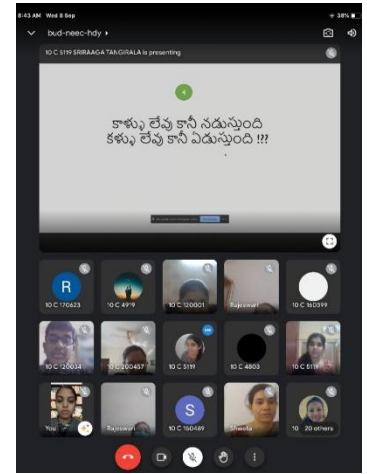


## TELUGU BHASHA DINOTSAVAM

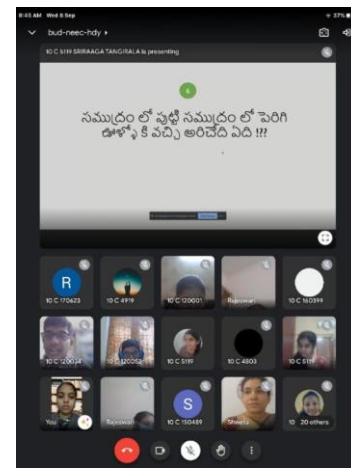
