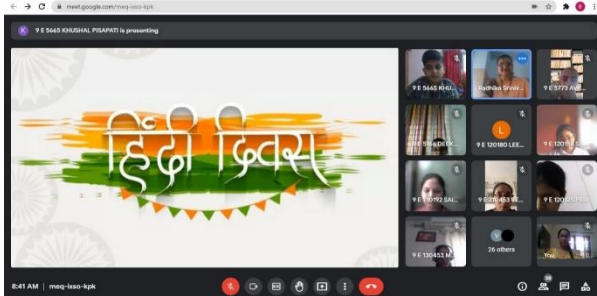


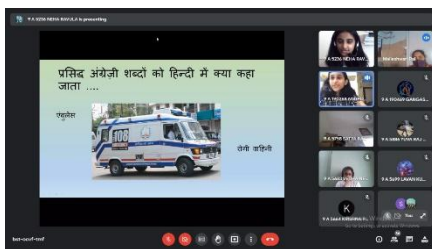
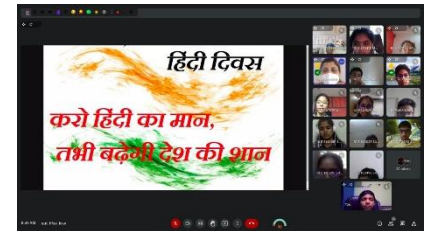
HINDI DIWAS CELEBRATIONS
