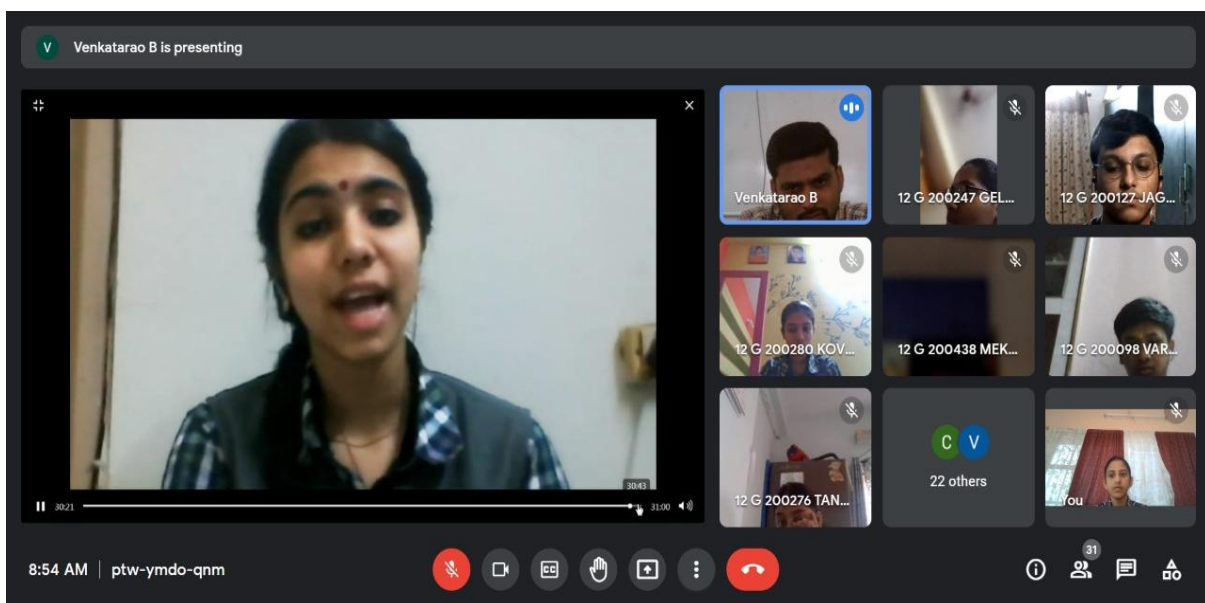
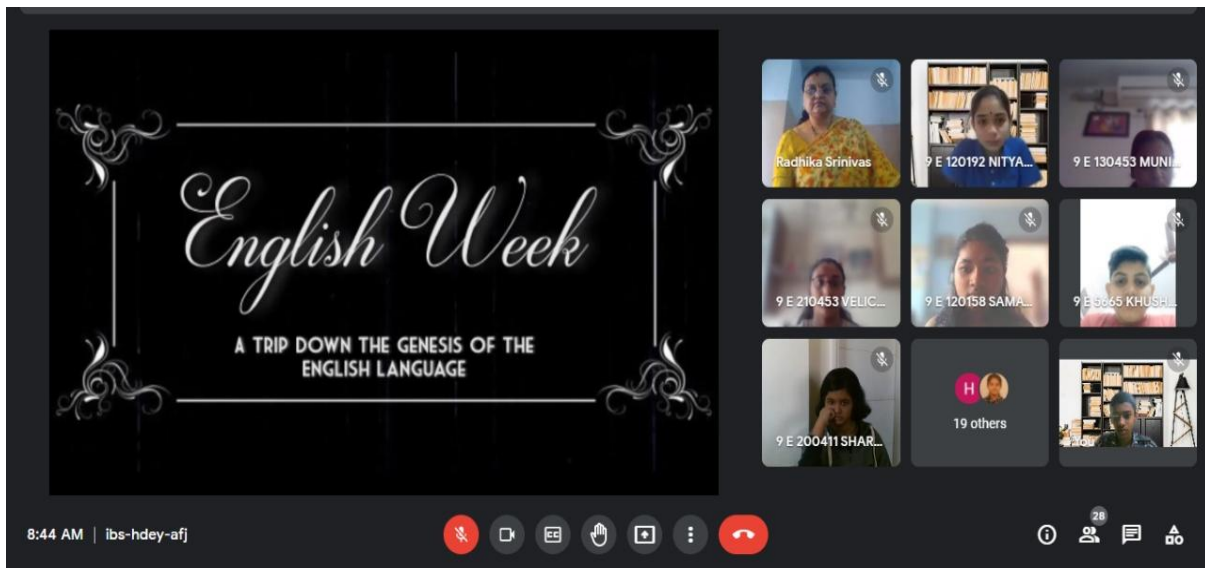


# ENGLISH WEEK
