It was a wonderful session wherein she enlightened the teachers

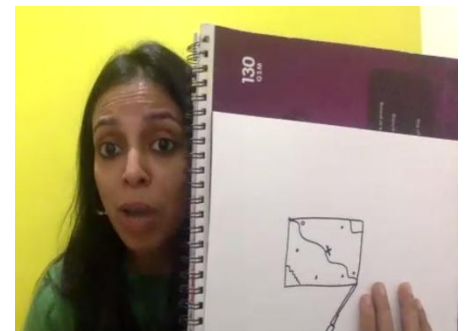


about how to tell a story, the elements that turn a story into a powerful performance and how to incorporate storytelling in the

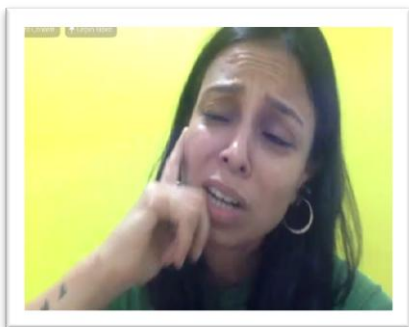


classroom.
