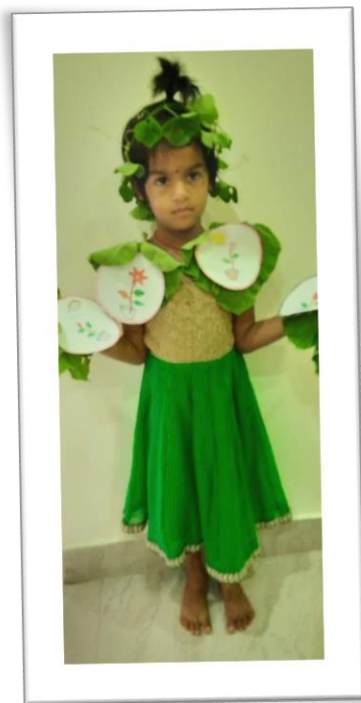


HARITA HARAM at DDMS P Obul Reddy Public School

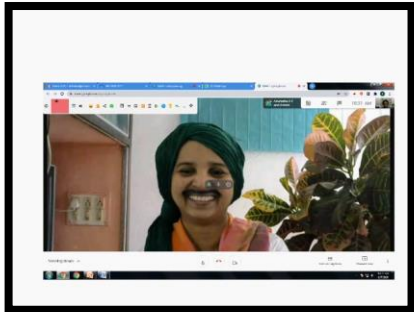
