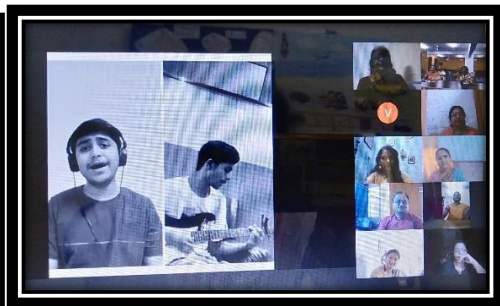

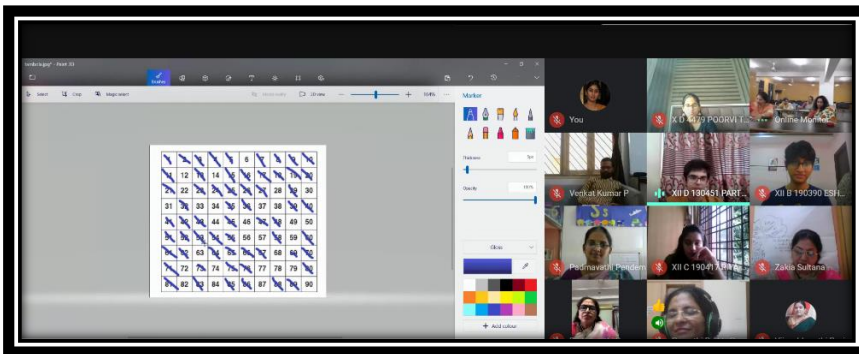
The programmes were well coordinated, under the guidance of Principal Mrs Latha Shankar and Vice Principal Mrs Vinitha Anil.
