FIELD TRIP REPORT

CLASS: VI, VII & VIII

Trips and excursions are an integral part of the curriculum. Children who experience holistic development during their school years, grow up to become global citizens. Giving equal weightage to both indoor as well as outdoor activities is what will make children, well prepared for what lies outside in the real world.

Field trips provide an interactive learning environment and aims at developing critical thinking skills, foster a sense of teamwork and community among the students and erases classroom boredom.

The school organized field trips for classes VI, VII & VIII, on the 25th of September, 2023.

<u>Students of Class VI</u> were taken to Chowmahalla Palace or the palace of the Nizams of Hyderabad, located in the heart of the city. The Chowmahalla Palace is a magnificent edifice that once served as the seat of power of the rulers of the Asaf Jahi dynasty (the Nizams). Students were awestruck seeing the beauty of the palace which was constructed in the late 18th century, consisting of two courtyards as well as the grand Khilwat (The Darbar hall), fountains, and gardens.







<u>Students of Class VII</u> were taken to the Archaeological Museum and Public Gardens. They enjoyed watching the paintings of 16th century cannons used during the wars, Buddhist scriptures etc. They were enlightened about the importance of preserving such precious artefacts for the future generations to witness.







Students of class VIII were taken to the Birla Planetarium and Public Gardens. Public Gardens provided children with an opportunity to relax and engage in various outdoor games, whereas Birla Planetarium was indeed a flight through the Universe. The cosmic presentation at the planetarium explained briefly about stars, constellations and about the early space voyages. The skies came alive on the massive dome theatre. The show was extremely enthralling and provided a good visual experience as well as factual knowledge of astronomy to our enthusiastic learners. Over all, the visit was so thrilling, educative, and informative to the children.
