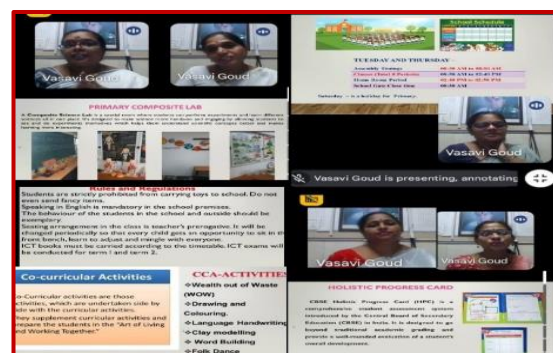
insights into the academic framework, teaching methodologies, classroom practices, and learning goals for the year.
