The sixth edition of YÜGEN commenced on 22nd August 2026 with an inspiring Opening Ceremony graced by Chief Guest Dr. B. Bala Bhaskar, former Ambassador of India to Norway and currently Professor at the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA), and Guest of Honour Sri S. V. Rao, Chairman.
