From the desk of LKG teachers:

We are going to tell you about the early programme lesson **“FUN WITH WATER”**

In this lesson, students will engage in doing simple water based experiments.

They will be encouraged to estimate how many beads it will take to fill a container half full of water for the water to spill over; predict which materials will mix in the water; and identify items that will sink and float.

In maths time, they will learn to recognise and write the number 5 through actions, rhyme, five frame box, and tracing in the sand. They will observe and share whether a glass is full, half-full or empty.

In language time, they will recognise the shape, sound and familiar words that begin with the letters ‘Ff’ and ‘Ll’ and write these letters later.

Rather than simply being told about things, students will use skills of estimation, prediction and observation to find out about things from their everyday life.

At home, your child can be encouraged to experiment by putting different things in water to observe the process of sinking and floating. He/she could also find out simple things like how many mugs of water it will take to fill up a bucket.
