From the desk of LKG teachers:

We are going to tell you about the early programme lesson on **Story Fun!**

In this lesson, students will learn about the value of self-help and helping others through the medium of two stories.

Students will try to predict what is happening in the story “The Thirsty Crow” and “The Lion and the Mouse” first by looking at the pictures, familiar letters or words from the text. They will also draw events from the story and engage in pretend play to reconstruct or act out events and roles.

During Language time, students will recognise the form and sound of the letters ‘Bb’ and ‘Jj’ through stories, rhymes and actions.

During Maths time, students will recognise, name, show, trace and write the ‘6’. They will also name, count and show a collection of 1-6 items using counters and block.

Rather than just listening to the story passively or learning what is happening in them through rote, students predict what will happen in stories by looking at the visuals, form and sound of letters from the text and then draw events from the story and describe the same to peers.

At home, you can encourage your child to look at story books and then try to predict what is happening in them.
