From the desk of LKG teachers:

We are going to tell you about the Early Programme lesson on "Chirpy birds"

In this lesson, Students will learn that birds are animals that have wings, feathers, beak, claws and that most of them are capable of flying.

The students will listen to a story and observe pictures of different birds to learn about the features and find out what is same or different in them. They will then explore the nest, food and calls of different birds. Finally they will draw a bird and colour it. The students will identify, name, show and write the numbers **1 to 9** through activities, manipulatives, and number rhymes. Students will revise the form and sound of all the letters taught in class through stories, rhymes and actions.

Rather than just learning about the names of birds through rote, the skills to compare a contrast will be used by students to learn about Birds. The focus is kept on exploring a different aspect each day from their different habitats, food habits, calls, nests and eggs.

At home, you can take your child to observe a bird sanctuary or the zoo to learn more about birds
