**Dear parent,**

**Thank you parents for your great support and cooperation for making the “Sports Fest” a grand success.**

**We are going to tell you about the Early Programme lesson on **Shadows.****

**In this lesson, students will cast shadows inside and outside the class and observe the shadows of things around them.**

**The week will begin with students creating shadows by standing in front of a class wall and using torch light from behind to observe the shadows created by their body. Then, they will observe shadows outside in the sun. They will sing a song and listen to a story on shadows of animals and draw the same. Students will recognize 1 more than a number up to 9 and learn about the concept more and less through activities and manipulatives. They will name, show and write Zero “0” and Number “10”. Students will practice writing Aa to Zz in sequence.**

**Rather than simply listening or observing pictures, students will experience creating shadows using torch light with objects in class. They will also take a walk outside to observe their own shadows and shadows of other things around them.**

**At home, you can help by making the child guess what shadows they have made using their hands in torchlight against a wall.**
