**From the Desk of UKG Teachers**

We are going to tell you about the early Programme lesson on **wild and free**.

In this lesson, students will understand that animals have characteristics that allow them to live in their habitats.

Students will first listen to a story to learn about animals in the jungle. They will learn about the food habits of the animals, their body parts and the space that need to make their habitats.

During **Math's time** students will learn to represent the numbers 13 and 14 by making bundles of ten and extra with the help of objects .students will learn to read and write number names 13,14,15,16 and 17.

During **Language time**, students will draw and talk about one event from the story. They will use past, present and future tenses. Students will learn to write "O" sound words.

Rather than expecting the students to use tenses on their own, strategies are used to help them talk about what things looked like in the past, what they look like now and what they will look like in the future.

At home, ask your child to name an animal and what it was as a baby, such as "This is a Kangaroo. As a baby, it was a Joey."

It would be great if your child can talk about the number of different things ,such as the story books they had, have now and might have in the future, to learn about the tenses.
