From the Desk of UKG Teachers

We are going to tell you about the Early Programme lesson on Wonder Pets

In this lesson, students will understand that pet and farm animals have certain needs such as food home and care to grow and stay healthy.

They will learn about pet animals through singing rhymes, playing with toys, watching a role - play playing games, engaging in pretend play and talking to a vet.

During Language time, students will break apart words into sounds, and put together sounds of letters to make the word. They will also learn to read and write simple sentences using sight words.

During Math's time, students will build graphs using objects and pictures. They will compare the favorites colours and pet animals among their classmates. Students learn number names.

Rather than just comparing data, students will gather information and show this in a graph to answer some of their questions. They will apply this skill to show animals that eat grass and those that do not.

At home, your child can build towers using LEGO blocks and compare which is taller, longer or shorter than others.

It would be great if your child can be asked to identity how many more or how many fewer will be needed to make towers longer, shorter or the same as the other.
