BLOCK COMMENTARY Date:21/10/19 to 25/10/19 **WEEK: 26 BLOCK NO: 14** FROM THE DESK OF UKG TEACHERS; We are going to tell you about the early programme lesson on Neighbourhood. In this lesson, students will learn what a neighbourhood is and the qualities for being a good neighbor. They will go for a neighbourhood walk; notice different places and people who work there to know what makes a neighbourhood. They will refer from a story and few pretend situations; other qualities of a good neighbour. During Math's time, students will learn to put together and break apart the numbers 16 to 19 by making bundles of 10 and counting extras. They will also make a living graph to show places in the neighbourhood. Students will also learn and write number names. During Language time, students will write words that they see in the neighbourhood by copying or sounding them out. They will then read the common words. Students will also identify, learn and write 'u' sound words. Rather than just reading from the word wall, students first use the words to share their experiences, and then build sentences with the structures, "In my neighbourhood there is a" Then they read the sentences. At home, your child can make drawings of common words and then read them every day.
