FROM THE DESK OF UKG TEACHERS:

We are going to tell you about the Early programme lesson on Toys.

In this lesson, students will learn that toys are made of different materials, move in different ways and have changed over time.

Students will present their toys and compare them to learn how they are different.

During Maths time, students will compare numbers 1-10 using dice games and ice-cream sticks. They will first count forward and backward and then show numbers before, after and in between.

During Language time, students will listen to stories, sing rhymes, do associated actions, name things, put together puzzles and group pictures to identify the beginning sound of the digraphs /ch/ and /sh/. They will also learn to read and write names of Fruits.

During II Language, students will learn to identify, read and write Telugu and Hindi letters.

Rather than just imitating an action, students will observe how differently toys move, show the action, connect the action with the word and use the action word in sentences with a structure such as: 'One way to move toys is by ..pushing, pulling, spinning, swirling or winding'.

At home, your child can group toys by the way they move. It would be great if your child can be prompted to use action words in an unfamiliar context.
