FROM THE DESK OF UKG TEACHERS:



We are going to tell you about the Early programme lesson on *When the Wind Blows*.

In this lesson, students will feel the presence of wind and learn that wind can move things.

Students will observe things which fly under the effect of a fan moving at a high speed. They will then predict things that can move and those that cannot when blown. Then, they will verify their predictions too. 

During Language time, students will listen to stories, sing rhymes, do an associated action, name things, put together puzzles and sort to identify the beginning sound of the digraph /th/. They will also learn new words to describe the effects of wind.

During Maths time, students will compare numbers between 1 – 20 by walking the path forward and back. They will count the numbers 1 more and 1 less than the previous. The students will also identify patterns in number names to read and write.

Rather than just learning the spellings of the Number Names, students will compare the lengths of the names, clap the pattern, e-clap-e-clap-e-clap, replace clap with letters of Number Names.

At home, help your child notice patterns in Number Names.

It would be great if your child can notice patterns in other words too. This will help him/her spell words.

During II Language, students will learn to identify, read and write Telugu and Hindi letters.
