FROM THE DESK OF UKG TEACHERS:

We are going to repeat last week's same Block this week also about the Early programme lesson on *Marvellous Machines*.

In this lesson, students will understand that machines are used to make work easy. They will learn that machines have changed over time.

Students will experiment on slides and planks to learn how slopes can be used to slide things down and pull things up. They will examine how a see-saw works and can be used to lift things. They will compare machines we see today with those in the past.

During Maths time, students will compare numbers between 1 – 20. They will identify the order of routines in school and then order in numbers. They will use number cards and number strings to show numbers before, after and in between. The students will also learn to identify, read and write Number Names.


During Language time, students will identify the beginning sounds in words, name things that begin with a blend, make picture cards and write the word for the card. They will describe new words.

Rather than just exploring different kinds of machines, they will apply their learning to put together a machine and further explore it.

At home, your child can be asked to use picture words of blends to help him/her read.

It would be great if your child can write words on picture cards, shuffle them and deal to play. The player who places a card over another with the same beginning blend wins the hand.

During II Language, students will learn to identify, read and write Telugu and Hindi letters.
