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FROM THE DESK OF UKG TEACHERS:

Thank you parents for your kind co-operation and support in making the SPORTS FEST a grand success. Hope you enjoyed.

We are going to tell you about the Early programme lesson on *safety*.

In this lesson, students will understand that the choices they make can influence their safety.

Students will brainstorm which places, people and things they need to be safe from at home and in school. Students will learn that there is both good and bad touch and that we need to say 'No' to bad touch and 'Tell' a trusted adult about it.

During Language time, students will sing rhymes, identify beginning sounds in words, name things that begin with a sound and make picture word cards. They will describe new words. They will also learn to read and write "This" Q and A.

During Maths time, students will first identify the pattern of 1 and 2 by singing a rhyme and using a number string. In the end, students will relate the pattern in colours to the pattern in numbers. They will also learn to identify, read and write Number Names.

Rather than just skip-counting the pattern of 2, students notice the pattern and work out the pattern on number strings.

At home ask your child to write the numbers in order and count. Then ask them to count by missing a number. Start from number 2.

It would be great if your child can extend the pattern of 2. The longer he/she extends the pattern, the better he/she will get at identifying the pattern.

During II Language, students will learn to identify, read and write Telugu and Hindi letters.
