From the Desk of **UKG** teachers:



We are going to tell you about the early programme lesson on A HUNDRED.

In this lesson, students will understand how much is a hundred. How many ways are there to count to 100? How many words are hidden in a hundred?

They will sing a song of 'smile' and brainstorm 100 reasons to smile. Students will count and sow 100 seeds. They will notice how people change when they turn 100.

During Language time, students will read three-letter words with the vowel 'e'. Students will use letter cards to make words that are hidden in one big word – hundred. They will also learn to write Opposites.

During Maths time, students will extend the pattern of 2. They will sing the centipede poem to realize yet another way to count – 50 and 50 more. Students will count on fingers to 100 and make bundles of 10 and count to 100.

Rather than just counting by rote, students will estimate how many there are in a set and then count to realize that there are different ways to count to 100.

At home, ask your child to count how many steps it takes them to reach different places at home and within the neighbourhood.

It would be great if your child can identify and do 100 things in a day, in a week, in a month or even in a year.

During II Language, students will learn to identify, read and write Hindi/Telugu letters.
