BLOCK 21

From the Desk of the UKG teachers:

We are going to tell you about the Early Programme Lesson on "Money Magic".

In this lesson, students will brainstorm on what money is for. Where does money come from and what can money not buy? They will identify the difference between needs and wants.

They will conclude that we need to work to get money. Students will sort pictures of a need from those of a want. They will then infer from situations what money cannot buy.

During Language time, students will use singular and plural nouns ending with the letter's'. They will listen to a story, sort and draw pictures to show one and many and they will also learn to write Opposites.

During Maths time, students will sort coins. They will make patterns using coins. Students will put together coins of different denominations to show the tagged amount. Students will guess whether they will get a heads or tails when they toss a coin and learn that a coin can land on any side-'Heads' or 'Tails'. Students will also learn to write in Ten, Bigger and smaller numbers.

Rather than just identifying coins, students are encouraged to show the value of a product using different coin combinations.

At home, your child can be encouraged to pay for things that cost less than 10 rupees using coins.

It would be great if your child can count coins in his/her money bank once a week.

In II Language, students will learn to identify, read and write Hindi/Telugu letters.
