Dip your right hand in container A and your left hand in container C. Keep them there for 1 to 2 minutes. Take both hands out and place them simultaneously into container B (tap water).	Observations & Conclusion: Right hand (coming from warm water): Feels cool when placed in tap water. Left hand (coming from ice-cold water): Feels warm when placed in tap water. Conclusion: The same tap water in container B feels cool to one hand and warm to the other. This proves that our sense of touch is subjective and cannot reliably tell us the true degree of hotness or coldness of an object. We need a standard device like a thermometer to measure temperature accurately.	Fever monitoring: Doctors cannot rely on a hand placed on a forehead to prescribe medication. They need an accurate digital or infrared thermometer to identify high fevers and prevent seizures or brain damage. Preserving vaccines: Lifesaving vaccines and medicines must be stored at precise temperatures (usually between 2°C and 8°C). A deviation of just a few degrees can ruin the medicine.
