

WORKSHOP ON TEACHERS AS DESIGNERS OF INSTRUCTION

The Pre-Primary and Primary Teachers along with Ms. K C Srivani, Primary Headmistress attended a 2-hour workshop on “Teachers as Designers of Instruction” conducted by Skybooks on 29.11.2025. The workshop was facilitated by Ms. Aisha Siddiqa, an experienced educator and resource person.

The session focused on guiding teachers to understand and apply the principles of instructional design in a systematic and meaningful manner. The workshop emphasized step-by-step learning of instructional design, enabling teachers to structure their teaching more effectively. Participants also practiced writing aims, objectives, and comprehensive instructional plans aligned with student learning needs.



A key highlight of the session was the introduction of the ADDIE Model (Analysis, Design, Development, Implementation, Evaluation) as a structured approach to designing impactful lessons. The workshop further included various grammar teaching techniques to support effective language instruction



in classrooms.

Teachers were trained on strategies for comprehending passages using WH-questions, helping students develop deeper understanding and critical thinking while reading. Additionally, the session covered different reading techniques suited for early learners, enhancing fluency and comprehension. Practical guidelines on sentence formation rules for beginners were also discussed to strengthen foundational language skills.

Various fun activities were also conducted in adherence with the concepts explained, and all teachers participated actively, making the session lively and collaborative.
